

# Open Lunch Privileges for Glenbrook Off-Campus

Some students wish to have open lunch at Off-Campus. We consider open lunch to be a privilege and not a right. In order to be granted this privilege they must meet certain expectations for at least six weeks. At the end of this period students may apply to their case manager. These expectations are:

1. The student must be passing all classes with a B or better.
2. The student must attend school at a rate of 90% or higher.
3. The student must be on time and stay for the whole day 90% of the time.
4. The student must follow all school rules and have no more than one **Minor** behavioral incident per week
5. The student may have no more than one **Major** behavioral incident per quarter. Failure to meet this expectation will result in the immediate revocation of their privilege
6. The student must return on time from lunch.
7. The student must follow all school rules as if they were on campus.

Students who fail to live up to the expectations will be warned that their behavior may jeopardize their ability to have open lunch. In some cases, as detailed above, the open lunch privilege will be removed without warning.

I will abide by all the rules of open lunch for Glenbrook Off-Campus.
